COLLECT: Almighty and everlasting God, direct our actions according to Thy good pleasure: that we may deserve to abound in good works in the name of Thy beloved Son: Who with Thee liveth...

OFFERTORY: God hath established the world, which shall not be moved: Thy throne, O God, is prepared from of old, Thou art from everlasting.

SECRET: Grant, we beseech Thee, almighty God, that the gifts now offered in the sight of Thy Majesty may obtain for us both the grace of tender devotion, and the reward of a blessed eternity. Through our Lord.

<u>COMMUNION</u>: Take the Child and His mother and go into the land of Israel: for they are dead who sought the life of the Child.

<u>POST-COMMUNION</u>: By the virtue of this mystery, O Lord, may our vices be purged away and our just desires fulfilled. Through our Lord.
