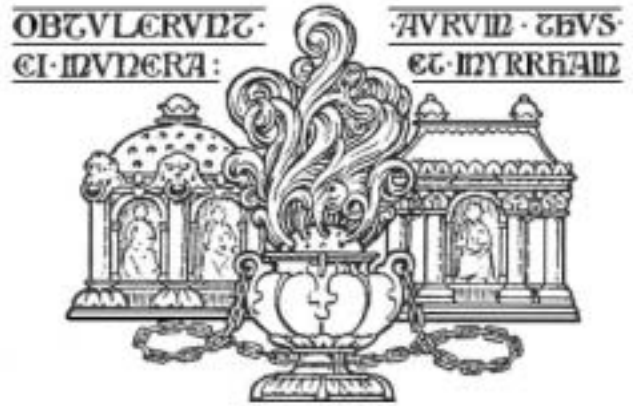


Tridentine Rite
